Indoor T&F underway at Cardiff

The indoor track season started this weekend and Team Bath AC athletes were out in force and produced personal bests, wins and even a club record.

At Cardiff, in the Welsh Athletics Junior Open (inc. SW Champs), there was a win for Eleanor Webster in the 300m in 45.82 and personal bests for Gemma Baker in the U/17 200m in 30.75, Josie Rucker in the U/15 200m in 30.15, Alex Knight in the U/15 300m in 44.06, Nynka Rucker in the U/15 300m in 46.81, Caitlin Mander in the U/15 high jump with 1m36 and Eleni Francis in the U/15 triple jump with 10m01, which is a new Club record. Alice Wilson got a PB in the U/15 long jump with 4m70.

Eleni picked up a couple of SW medals: she claimed Silver in the morning in the U15 Long Jump (4.83m) and Bronze in the afternoon in the U17 Triple Jump (there wasn't an U15 comp) jumping a big PB of 10.01m. She also ran in the 200m later in the afternoon finishing just outside of the medals in 28.87.

Alice Wilson, bronze in the long jump and Byron Mander, gold in the shot, were also South West medallists.

The SW Champs were held in conjunction with the Open Meeting, so the positions given in the results below were the overall positions in the field and in their respective heats on the track.
