YDL UAG Regional Final

Team Avon, of which Team Bath AC are a part, won the Regional Final of the YDL Upper Age Group on Sunday at Yate. The final, provisional scores were as follows:-

Among the many TeamAvon winners were TBAC athletes Peter Adeosun in the U/17 mens high jump A with 1m85, Ellery Cole in the U/20 men's 800m B in 2.02.26, Femi Akimbobola in the U/20 men's 400m hurdles B in 63.64, Gabriella Holt in the U/20 women's discus B with 21m41, the U/20W 4 x 400m relay team, which included India Ibbotson, in 4.06.71, Kiran Carter in the U/17 men's high jump B with 1m70, Mia Bates in the U/17W 300m hurdles B in 48.14, Abby Rucker in the u/17W triple jump B with 8m67, Sophie Harrison in the U/17W shot B with 9m12 and Javelin B with 27m35 and the U/17W 4 x 300m relay, which included Sophie Moore and Mia Bates, in 2.59.8.

Second places went to Ben Game in the U/20m 100m B in 11.65, Ellery Cole in the U/20 400m hurdles A in 58.16, Becci Ousby in the U/20W 100m hurdles A in 18.80, Jake Cover in the U/17 men's 100m hurdles A in 14.33, William Scammell in the U/17 men's long jump B with 5m65 and Charlotte Longden in the U/17W long jump B with 4m36.

This was a step up for team Avon, with the best teams in the Midlands and Wales taking part and they did very well, with many of the big names missing. Next stop is the National Final at Manchester on September 8

Bristol & West Fast 5000s

Despite some heavy rain on the drive to Yate, an hour later and it was almost perfect conditions for distance races on the track. Four of us Seniors were competing in the series of paced 5000m races.

First up was Chris Elmer, who stuck close to his pacemaker (16:30 pace) for much of the race, but gradually lost touch in the later stages and eventually finished in 16:47 equalling his PB set in Cheltenham a couple of weeks ago. In the next race (16:00 pace) James Donald was hoping for a sub 16:30, and ran an excellent race, holding back mid-pack early on before picking up the pace in the last mile to run a huge PB (50+seconds) of 16:11. Peter Grist, in the same race as James, but not in top shape at the moment, ran 16:35.

Having ambitiously given a target time of 15:50 a few months ago, I'd been placed in the following race, paced to 15:25. On the start line I was just hoping not to be completely out of my depth. From the gun, I settled in right at the back, trying to keep as comfortable as possible without losing touch. I reached 3K only a couple of seconds outside my 3000m time at the TBAC Open last month. In the latter stages I couldnt hold the same pace, and gradually saw my chances of a sub-16 disappear, but was pleased to nevertheless finish with a PB of 16:06, to round out a pretty successful night for us TBAC.

Thanks to B&W for putting on the really fun event - its great to have such good distance track races close to home - and also to Eliot Ball who may have temporarily retired his

running legs, but came along to offer enthusiastic support and helpfully shouted split times.

And meanwhile, earlier in the evening in Milton Keynes, Aaron Pritchard had also run a 5000m track PB of 15:18.
