Avon League 3, Yate

Report from the third Avon League match which took place at Yate on 11th August, in which TBAC finished third behind North Somerset and Yate but ahead of Bristol and the rest.

Despite some shocking weather, there were some great performances. Winners for TBAC were Emily Jones in the U/13 girls high jump with 1m35, a new PB with Ciara Galvin in second with 1m25, sister Sophie Jones won the U/13 javelin with 17m66, Lottie Singleton won the U/15 javelin with 21m77 and Eleni Francis won the U/15 girls triple jump with 9m90. In the older age groups Abi Davies won the senior 100 m in 12.7 whilst Becci Ousby won the senior 400 m in 64.2 and Eleanor Webster won the U/17 1500 m in 4.59.4.

On the male side, it was Alex day, with wins for Alex Knight in the U/15 boys 800m in 2.15.6 and Alex Hearn in the U/13 boys long jump with 4m12 with Alex Hearn also finishing second in the 800m in 2.29.6 and third in the 100 m in 14.0, with yet another Alex, this time Alex Burton finishing second in the U/17 200 m in 23.0 and third in the 100m in 11.5.

Outstanding performance of the day came, once more, from Femi Akinbobola with a hat trick of wins in the senior 100m in 11.3, the 200m in 22.7 and the 110m hurdles in 16.0, which broke the long standing League record! He also brought the 4x100 m relay team home a long way ahead of the opposition in 46.8.

Other male winners were Dominic Murray in the U/15 boys 80m hurdles in 13.5, Jake Cover in the U/17 100m hurdles in 14.1, Ransford Ako'nai in the senior long jump with 5m21 and Keelan Tucker in the U/17 men's discus with 28m63.

Second places went to Sophie Jones in the U/13 girls 75 m in 10.8 and the 70m hurdles in 13.6, the same time as the "winner" (she was robbed), Emily Jones in the U/13 1200m in 4.25.9, Lottie Silverton in the U/15 1500m in 5.10.4 and high jump,with 1m40. For the boys, second places went to Dominic Murray in the U/15 long jump,with 5m13, Joe Carter in the U /27 100m in 11.4, Imam Qazi in the vet men's 100m in 12.6 and Lucas Regazzo in the men's 110m hurdles in 18.0.

Third places went to Emilia Rawstorne in the U/15 300 m in 45.8, Emily Jones in the U/13 70 m hurdles in 14.0, Phoebe Card in the U/17 100 m in 13.1, Sophie Moore in the U/17 300 m in 44.7, Dominic Murray in the U/15 100 m in 12.4, Sam Walker in the U/15 boys shot with 8m43, Joel Mattacks in the senior 100 m in 12.0 and Joe Dixon in the U/17 long jump with 4m15.



Yate AC Open Meet & Avon Champs

A small number of TBAC athletes competed at the second Open Meeting at Yate on Wednesday 14th August. The meeting incorporated Avon County Championships for some events which included the 200m races for all age groups, in which Sophie Jones won the only medal of the evening, the bronze medal for the U/13 girls 200m in 29.97, her first race at the distance. Other non championship performances included a win for Ciara Galvin in the U /13 girls high jump with 1m35 with Emily Jones in second place with 1m30. Second place also for Sam Walker in the U/15 boys javelin with 35m82 and Phoebe Card in the U/17 women's 100 m in13.02.

It was a disappointing turn out from TBAC athletes, especially in the 800m races, which is a strong event for our club. This was a county championship for 200m, 800m, javelin and triple jump and I would have expected a better turn out.

Yeovilton 5K

Freya Spruit smashed her 5 km personal best by over half a minute at Yeovilton with a superb run last Wednesday evening. 16 year old Freya who was first junior lady and third overall lady in a highly competitive field recorded a time of 18:34, 34 seconds faster than her previous best for the distance.

Freya wasn't the only 16 year old to have a successful evening at Yeovilton as Alex Parsons finished second junior man and seventh overall with a fantastic time of 15:56 just 3 seconds outside his PB. Just behind Alex in ninth place was Aaron Pritchard who recorded another sub 16 minute 5 km carrying on from his recent successes on the track.

At the other end of the age scale Dave Coales recorded a season's best of 17:35 to finish third vet 40 and 19th overall.

Thankfully after a day of non stop rain the weather brightened up in time for the 7.15pm start making personal and season bests possible.

The Yeovilton 5 km course has been changed this year due to roadworks with the temporary course used last Wednesday being slightly slower than the traditional course, that said with 9 guys going sub 16 minutes and the winner posting a time of 15.02 the temporary course is still pretty fast!
