Parkrun monthly results report

January

January saw the first month of the new Club 5k championship, and it was well attended with 36 club members competing at one or more of the six parkruns selected for this year's competition. A third of those runners completed two different park runs, with Mike Dooley showing early intent by completing three. At this stage, average time per parkrun is the easiest way to see who is leading, and with a 16:50 run at Chipping Sodbury, Otto Copping leads the way. But, with Chipping Sodbury probably the fastest course on the list, will he be able to keep up that average on the tougher courses. Junior Charlie Haines and veteran Simon Brace are tied in second place on 17:46.

Away from the championship, there were over 60 different runners taking part in a parkrun in January, with a huge spread of times. Congratulations to all those who took part. And, on that note, if you did but can't see your name on the results please check that you have set up your club name on your parkrun profile, and that your membership is up to date, otherwise let me know by emailing me here, and I'll look into it.

On the day it would be great if you can wear TBAC kit (hoodie/t-shirt/vest etc).

If you can't make 12th March, the plan is that following on we will aim to help parkrun regularly by providing pacers on the first parkrun of each month, and we may plan another takeover to align with one of those weekends in the summer.
