

Last Saturday, in Victor Harbor, South Australia, Jo Thompson achieved a 100% age grading in the local Parkrun with a time of 19.58. Jo has been in South Australia for almost two months visiting her son and new grandson and this was her seventh parkrun since arriving. She has been closing in on a 100% percent performance in recent weeks and finally achieved it on this relatively flat coastal parkrun. Fortunately, the winds were also light on the exposed path. Jo reached the dead turn, at the half way point, in 9.55 and maintained her pace to the finish line, to narrowly duck under 20 minutes and achieve the milestone. It was a lonely run as she caught the second and third placed men well before the turn and the leader had a minute and a half gap.

That age grade performance ensured that Jo was the best ParkRunner in Australia and fifth in the world for that week's global parkrun. Quite an achievement.

Jo has been training with the Adelaide Harriers running club since she arrived in Australia and will be running the Clare Valley 10km this weekend.

Club 5k Championship & Parkrun Report March

Despite the flurries of snow outside as I write this, March generally brought more pleasant conditions for Parkrunning, and the drying out of some of the wetter courses brought faster times (either that or you're all getting fitter). Nearly 60% of the best TBAC times at Bath Skyline were run in March, and we now have nearly 50 TBACers who have run on at least one of the championship courses. Some great running from our vets with four V50 men and a V60 (Niall Urquhart) averaging under 20:00 per run. Curiously though, there's currently only a single V40 (Simon Brace) averaging under 20 minutes, although Ben Holding and Tim Hill will be pushing to join him soon.

Looking further afield, Poole again crops up with an 18:01 from Issy Davies as she improved by nearly a minute from last month, and Niall Caley's 15:13 virtually matching his February time. His was the fastest run this month, but there were other notable runs too: Owen Davies had an excellent run at Cardiff to break 18 minutes, and excellent runs from juniors with Charlie Haines running 17:31 at Pomphrey Hill and Tobi Loughin 18:19 at Chippenham.
