With the brilliant Weston-Super-Mare Prom 5-mile 2022/23 road series fully under way, the February iteration was highly anticipated as 198 runners listened intently to the Race Directors final race instructions, 7.30pm Thursday 16th February!

All runners charged into a slight head wind in a southerly direction, before the first of four 180 degree turns to be navigated after about 400m. The 2 x 2.5 mile up and down laps are flat and fast along the promenade, with plenty of marshals to keep all runners in line, whilst warning the local dog walkers of the impending stampede of runners heading their way⁶⁹. For a February race the conditions were favourable and the times achieved at all running levels reflected this.

Entry for a Club Athlete is just £8 and is great value. Parking close to the start/finish area is very accessible after 6pm!

1st Place went to Naomi Aylwin of Bristol & West AC in an impressive time of 30:10.


The Vets (V50) Category was also well contested!




Giulietta e Romeo Half Marathon
