

Track & Field By Di Viles and Mark Thomas

English Schools Track & Field Championships, Birmingham

Several TBAC juniors were selected by their County Schools Athletics Association to represent their County at the English Schools T&F Championships in Birmingham. With 1,844 athletes registered to compete this is, reputedly, the third largest athletics competition in the World (after the Olympics and the World Championships). Pride of place goes to the three TBAC athletes who medalled: bronze medals for Daisy Duncan (FU15) in the high jump and Charlie Staddon (MU20) in the 110m hurdles, and a gold medal for Dylan Stoneman (MU20) in the 2000m steeplechase.

TeamBath sent a severely depleted team to Neath on Saturday for the third YDL LAG match of the season and finished fourth overall, mainly due to our excellent U/15 boys team plus Gertie Blewitt and Rory Osborne.

Double A-winner was Tom White who won the U/15 boys 300m in 40.3, a new PB and 800m in 2.04.2 plus a second A place in high jump with another pb of 1.57. Emmanuel Daso won the U/15 boys long jump A with 4.70 and 200m B in 24.1 plus a second A place in 100m in 12.7. Joshua Davies won the U/15 boys 1500 m in 4.43.0 whilst William Game won the U/15 boys 80m hurdles in 13.3. Corey Summers won the U/15 boys javelin A with 44.53 and finished second in the discus with 20.45. In the U/13 boys age group, the sole winner was Rory Osborne with a win in the U/13 A javelin with a new pb of 28.82 and finished second A 800m in 2.26.2. Other B winners were Jacob Sanchez-Fulton in the U/15 boys 800m in 2.17.4, 80m hurdles in 13.9 and shot with 10.34, a new PB, Daniel Phelps in the U/15 1500m in 4.53.4 and Orson Pace in the U/15 boys high jump with 1.45.

Gertie Blewitt continued her excellent season with wins in the U/15 girls 300m in 42.7 and 800m in 2.25.5.

Second A places went to Thomas Southgate in the U/15 200m in 26.0 and Olivia Paul in the U/15 girls 1500m in 5.05.5. Second B places to Orson Pace in the U/15 boys shot with 7.83 and Thomas Southgate in the U/15 long jump with 2.94.







Youth Development League, Upper Age Group, Aberdare Sunday 2nd July

Athletes from Team Bath AC join with others from Bristol & West AC and Yate & District AC to form Team Avon for this competition for athletes in the U17 and U20 age groups. After three rounds Team Avon has finished top of the division and has qualified for the regional final in Rugby on Sunday 30th July.

Team scores were as follows:

A winners were Dylan Stoneman in the U/20 800m in 2.06.14, Charlie Staddon in the U/20 men's 110 hurdles in 14.65, both off the back of English Schools success; Dominic Murray in the U/20 men's long jump with 6.09, Tom Blackburn, returning from injury, in the U/20 men's high jump with 1.75, Eleni Francis in the U/20 women's long jump with 5.30, Jamie Semple in the U/17 men's high jump with 1.75, a new PB, Ellie Mullins in the U/17 women's 300m in 41.80 and Tilly Nickell in the U/17 women's 3000m in 10.39.14.

B winners were Dominic Murray in the U/20 men's 100m in 11.80, Ben Wagstaff in the U/20 men's 3000m in 9.36.24 and Jamie Semple in the U/17 men's 200m in 24.12.

Second A places went to Sam Walker (U/20 m javelin with 45.40), William Willetts (U/17 m triple jump, with 11.85), Ellie Mullins (U/17 w long jump, with 5.18) and Ned Blackman (U/20 m 800m in 2.22.31) whilst second B places went to William Willetts (U/27 m 800m in 2.22.38) and Esme McKenzie (U/17 w long jump with 4.30).

The steeplechase races at this meeting had to be cancelled because the water was leaking from the water jump as fast as it was being put in thus depriving Dylan Stoneman (MU20) of a race. The pole vault had to be abandoned because of high winds thus depriving Will Semple (MU17) of a competition.




