

On 24th/25th January the **Arc of Attrition UTMB** race took place on the South West Coastal Path over various distances (Arc 100-160Km; Arc 50-80Km; Arc 25-40Km).

In the **Arc 50** Martin Archbold finished 44th (5th MV45) in 10:58:28; Emily Griffiths 8th Female in 11:23:47 (cover photo and photo above); and Chris Maxwell 73rd; 4th MV50;

11:43:58.

In the **Arc 25** ultra specialist Kevin Meynard-Krause finished 10th; (3rd MV35; 3:13:40). Of the remaining TBAC runners Heather Fell was 16th Female (4:32:00), Florrie Betts was 21st Female (4:40:04); and Claire George (nee Hookway) 83rd Female (5:55:52) - photo below.


25th January, Tom Davies was the only TBAC runner at the **Midlands XC Champs**. Tom finished 58th in the Senior Men's race finishing in 44:30.

The next day, at the **Longleat 10k** in challenging weather, Aaron Pritchard had an excellent run finishing 2nd overall in a time of 36:44.

16th February, in the **Bramley 20 miler**, Will Maslin (26th; 2:11:17) and David Jenkins (29th; 2:12:58) continued their marathon training with solid runs.

The same day, Emily Griffiths ran the **Smartt Smasher 10k in Calne** finishing as 2^{nd} Female in a time of 41:56.

One of the performances of the day at the Keely Klassic in Birmingham (15th Feb) came from Justin Davies, who clocked 1:45.78 on his way to victory $\stackrel{\checkmark}{\not}$ Justin also broke the British U'23 i800m record, and it puts him seventh on the UK all-time indoor 800m list.

At the same event, Euan Murray competed in the mixed para men's 60m T64, placing 3rd with a massive PB of 7.95. Meanwhile Ellie Leather also clocked a SB of 4:15.68 finishing 5th in the Senior Women 1500m.



All Avon County Championship steeeplechase events will be incorporated into the Somerset County Championships at Yeovil on 7th/8th May (date TBC).
